Collage Embroidery Workshop Supplies:

Wood embroidery hoop (suggested size 8-12")
*This will be the hoop size for your main project

Wood embroidery hoop (suggested size 6")
*This will be the hoop for your practice stitches

Variety of fabrics:

- (1) One Fat quarter to be used as background fabric for your main project Variety of other fabrics with elements that can be used for fabric collage (fat quarter cuts of fabric work perfectly!)
- (1) Piece of fabric to fit inside of the 6" hoop (preferably a solid color)

Embroidery Needles (brand does not matter; I prefer Milliner's needles, but pick what you like!)
*A variety of sizes works well for working with beads

Heat n Bond Lite (or other similar fusible, paper-backed material) - 1/2 yard

Fiskars Micro-Tip Spring Action Scissors (I highly, highly recommend these for fussy cutting!)

Variety of threads for embroidery (suggested: Sue Spargo Eleganza Perle Cotton in sizes 3, 5 and 8)

Optional:

Textured materials: ribbon, lace, buttons, yarns, fabric yo-yos, pom-poms Beads: decorative beads, seed beads (size 8 and size 6), sequins

Books: Boho Embroidery 1 and/or 2 by Nichole Vogelsinger (optional, but I hear they are completely worth it!):)
